Performance Information

Students from the following levels will participate in one performance only: **Pre-Ballet 1, Pre-ballet 2 and Pre-Ballet 3.**

All other students will participate in two performances corresponding to their cast.

Pick Up and Drop Off

- Drop off and pick up for performances and rehearsal will be at the Stage Door at the Woodman Family Community and Performing Arts Center.
- **Rehearsals** - Students will be released after their piece has finished rehearsal.
- **Shows** - Students will not be released until the end of the show. The entire performance is expected to run approximately 1 hour.

Day of Show

- All dancers need to be at the studio at the specified **CALL** time for each performance. All students must arrive in **light makeup, with hair styled according to class instructions, and leotard and tights where applicable.** There will be limited space to change. Costume details will be emailed separately.
- **Parents will not be allowed backstage.** There will be chaperones for each class. **NO EXCEPTIONS PLEASE.**
- Students will be expected to remain at the theatre for the full performance since all students will participate in the final bow. The entire performance is expected to run approximately 1 hour.

Tickets are \$25.00 for reserved seating (free for children 2 and under seated on a ticketed patron's lap). Please note additional fees for phone, online orders, and mail delivery apply. Please take note that there is a limit of 4 tickets per student for the June 17th and 18th shows at 1pm only. This limitation will be applied until June 7th, 2023. After that date, all unsold seats will be released for sale. Please purchase your tickets as soon as possible.

Costumes

All costume fees and past due tuition balances must be paid in full by Friday, May 26th, otherwise students will not receive their costumes until all payments are complete.

All costumes will remain at the theatre until your final performance when those who purchased will get to take them home. Costumes for the Core Ballet levels 4 and up will be rental costumes that are the property of BRI. These costumes will reside at the studio.

Costume details for each pieces' requirements will be sent at a later date.

Food

- No eating will be allowed in costume during Culmination.
- No messy foods that could stain (I.e. Cheetos, grape juice, chocolate)
- ***Gum is not allowed in the theater.***

*****VERY IMPORTANT*****

There are students with nut allergies who participate in our performances and therefore we have adopted the policy of not allowing any foods containing nuts into the backstage dressing areas in the theater.

Miscellaneous

- We advise that your child wear a large button- or zipper-front shirt to the theater to be worn over their costumes.
- Students should bring quiet activities to the theatre. School of Ballet RI is not responsible for lost or stolen possessions. Use your discretion in sending valuable items to the theater.
- Nail polish, glitter and jewelry are **NOT** allowed.

Photos and Videos (not allowed, no exceptions)

- **PHOTOGRAPHY IS NOT ALLOWED** in the theatre during any rehearsal and/or performance. **VIDEO RECORDING IS NOT ALLOWED** in the theatre during the performances. This is a theater policy and must be followed. There will be a professional video available for purchase.
- A photographer will be at the studio to take pictures of our dancers in costume on Sunday, June 4th. Students wishing to be photographed during this time need to purchase a photo sitting session from School of Ballet RI no later than May 27th. The photographer will provide digital images only.
- A digital download of the performance will be available for purchase.

Volunteers Needed

Parents are needed to work backstage as chaperones, ushers and at the boutique table. If you are interested in helping during Culmination, an email will be sent to sign up at a later date. All backstage volunteers must have a BCI (Background Check) document to be submitted.

Several volunteer coordinators will be helping to organize these activities and will contact you with details.

There will be two chaperones per class backstage for supervision and to help touch-up hair. Chaperones will be asked to arrive at the theater 15 minutes prior to call time and will need to stay with the children for the entire show. Parents are allowed backstage only if working as a chaperone.
